## **BYLAW NUMBER 7**

**BYLAW CONCERNING**

**STUDENTS' ADMISSION**

**TO DEC PROGRAMS**

This bylaw was adopted for the first time by Board of Governors resolution number 1529 on June 17, 1994 and subsequently amended by resolution number 1971 on February 20, 2002, and resolution number 2354 on May 4, 2007.

Please note that the new text to the bylaw is presented in *italic* and underlined.

## **Article 1      GENERAL PROVISIONS**

### **1.01      Definitions**

The definitions set forth in Articles 1.01 of Bylaw Number 1 apply to Bylaw Number 7.

### **1.02      Designation**

The title of the present bylaw is "Bylaw concerning Students' Admission or Readmission to DEC Programs" and is designated as Bylaw Number 7.

## **Article 2      ADMISSION**

### **2.01**

The basic admissions requirements of the College are defined by the *Règlement sur le regime des études collégiales*, Section II.

### **2.02**

Even if applicants to programs meet the requirements of articles 2 and 4 of Section II of the *Règlement sur le regime des études collégiales*, they may be refused admission because of lack of places.

### **2.03**

Conditional on changes proposed by the MELS in regards to the CEGEP admissions criteria in the *Règlement sur le regime des études collégiales*, for the period starting with the Fall 2007 academic semester and extending until Winter 2010, successful completion of Mathematics 416 will be the minimum Mathematics requirement for CEGEP entrance.

However, for some pre-university programs designated by the MELS, candidates will be required to complete additional pre-requisites in Mathematics. Moreover, successful completion of Mathematics 514 will be obligatory for admission to some technical programs designated by the MELS which previously did not require specific Mathematics pre-requisites.
